Mawnan Christmas Lights Leaf Lantern Workshops



As part of the Mawnan Christmas Lights switch on this year on Friday 6th December 2024 we will be offering some fun crafty workshops in school to come and make your own leaf lantern. The lanterns will be part of a small lantern procession and then help to light up our school choir who will be singing that evening.

The workshops will be held on a choice of two days – you can drop in at any time on the Wednesday

27th November and Thursday 28th November after school in the hall between 3.30 and 4.30pm on these dates. Children will attend the workshops with an adult to help with the making of their lantern. Children attending clubs on those evenings are welcome to come at 4.15 to make their lanterns.

You will need to bring a cylinder shaped cheese box for each lantern you want to make (camembert/dairylea box etc.) and some collected dry autumnal leaves/pressed flowers/seed heads to decorate.

All the other materials including LED tealights will be provided.
