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### **Term Time Holidays**

The law does not grant parents an automatic right to take their child out of school during term time. Any absence from school will disrupt your child's learning. You may consider that a holiday will be educational, but your child will miss out on the teaching that their classmates will receive during your holiday. Attendance is vital to academic success and lost education poses a potential risk of underachievement. This is something we all have a responsibility to avoid.

The Department for Education no longer allows **Headteachers to grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances**. If you consider that your request for absence is exceptional you will need to complete an absence request form. If leave is not authorised and you nevertheless withdraw your child from school, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised absence.

If so, you will need to apply for a place in a reception class in September 2025 for your child by the deadline of **15 January 2025**. The deadline for applications is 15 January 2025



Please note: you will need to apply even if your child attends a school's nursery or preschool class. If a school is oversubscribed the fact that a child attends a school's nursery or pre-school, or a local nursery or pre-school, does not automatically guarantee a place at that school.
