The PTA will be meeting at school on the afternoon of Tuesday 5th April at 3:30pm in the gazebo. Everyone is welcome.

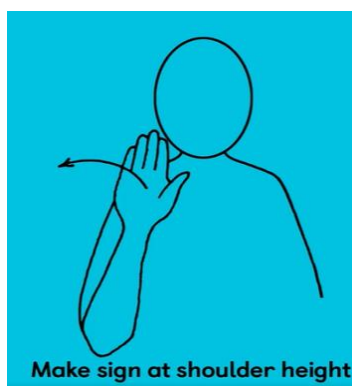
Easter and Eucharist
