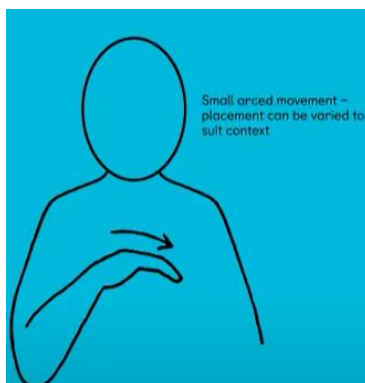


Fusion and Dart are also working with Neal, rugby coach from the Cornish Pirates every Friday.
