Lockdown 2

We are now in our second national lockdown and I have been asked to provide some clarification about the mixing of households.

Households are not allowed to mix but you are allowed to form a childcare bubble throughout the second lockdown.

The government states that: "A childcare bubble is where someone in one household provides informal (unpaid and unregistered) childcare to a child aged 13 or under in another household."

However, the childcare bubble is restricted to be only between the same two households. People can only form one childcare bubble. The government website states: **"For any given**

childcare bubble, this must always be between the same 2 households."

We will continue to do everything we can in school to keep your children safe and respectfully ask that all families strictly follow the government's guidance.

To keep us all safe please continue to follow our safety plans:

- If your child or anyone in your household is displaying symptoms or awaiting the outcome of a test, do not come to school - you must self-isolate the whole household during this time
- Maintain a 2 metre distance from other families and staff whilst at school (if this is not possible wear a mask)
- Do not come into the school building
- Arrive at the correct staggered time for drop off and pick-ups (only one parent to drop off)
- Swiftly exit the school grounds
- Do not gather in groups
- Follow the government's guidance outside of school at all times
