School Catering Vacancies

General Kitchen Assistant Vacancies

We are looking for two General Kitchen Assistants to work 16 hours a week during the lunchtime period, approx. 3 hours a day 11-2. 1st - Monday to Friday - Term time only based in one of our Truro schools. (38 working weeks)

2nd - Monday to Friday - Term time only, as a Mobile Catering Assistant. Must be able to drive and have your own car. Traveling costs will be paid. (39 working weeks)

Duties

General kitchen duties as directed by the Catering Manager (making baguettes and sandwiches and light prep), washing up, serving the students their lunchtime meal, clearing tables and chairs etc. You will work 38/39 weeks a year and also receive 4.8 weeks holiday pay.

The money is then spread over 12 months so that you will receive a salary every month.

This type of position would suit a person who has children at school as it is term time only or a person looking for a job that has a lot of holidays. Enhanced DBS needs to be completed for this role (paid for by us)
